

## **Water Resources (data provided by Alachua County Environmental Protection Division)**

- **Named Springs – 11** (Hornsby, Poe, Little Poe, Treehouse (resurgence), River Rise (resurgence), Darby, ALA930971, ALA930972 – on Santa Fe River; Glen, Boulware and Magnesia in eastern Gainesville/Alachua County – Glen and Boulware are intermediate aquifer springs). Other unnamed springs exist along the Santa Fe River; we know of at least two more at Poe Springs Park
- **Creeks (does not include the Santa Fe River) - 503 miles** (county-wide current GIS coverage includes intermittent and perennial streams)
- **Lake area – 51 square miles** (county-wide current GIS coverage)
- **Storm System Network - 408 miles** (stormwater network non-open channel for Gainesville urban area – line file)
- **Stormwater Ponds - 563** (stormwater network for Gainesville urban area GIS coverage individual ponds – point file )
- **Septic Systems – over 30,000** (county-wide FDOH 2009 assessment with 7,099 parcels not determined; the number of septic is likely higher)
