

Market Animal Sale



The 2009 Alachua County Youth Fair & Livestock Show's Steer, Swine, and Goat sale is the final event of this year's youth fair. These 4-H & FFA youth have completed an educational experience in livestock production. This project has provided "hands-on" experience while discovering why Agricultural Production is an important industry in the United States.

These members not only learn about Agriculture, but develop life skills such as, responsibility, leadership, and citizenship skills that will prepare them to be our future leaders of tomorrow.

Having local community support during this sale will make it possible for the young people to receive recognition, and save funds for further education after high school or a career.

As a Buyer you have the following choices:

1. Purchase an animal, Keep the Meat for your own use. This is called Custom Kill.
2. Purchase an animal, if you choose not to keep the meat, then resale the animal. A resale price will be announced on the sale day, and you pay only the difference between the bid price and the resale price.

Custom Kill

- ◆ Custom Kills must be paid for in full on the day of sale.
- ◆ Only the bidder that buys an animal will be allowed to purchase that carcass.
- ◆ Designated Processing facilities will be announced the day of the sale.
- ◆ A cutting and wrapping sheet must accompany the Custom Kill Animals.

Buying Examples

- ◆ Market Steer: 1200 pounds
- ◆ Bid Price: \$2.00/pound
- ◆ Choose Custom Kill
- ◆ Total Amount due: \$2400

- ◆ Market Swine: 250 pounds
- ◆ Bid Price: \$2.00
- ◆ Choose Example Resale Price \$.50
- ◆ Your Cost: \$2.00 - \$.50 = \$1.50/pound
- ◆ Total \$375

- ◆ Market Goat: 120 pounds
- ◆ Bid Price: \$1.50
- ◆ Choose Example Resale Price \$.50
- ◆ Your Cost \$1.50 - \$.50 = \$1.00/pound
- ◆ Total \$120

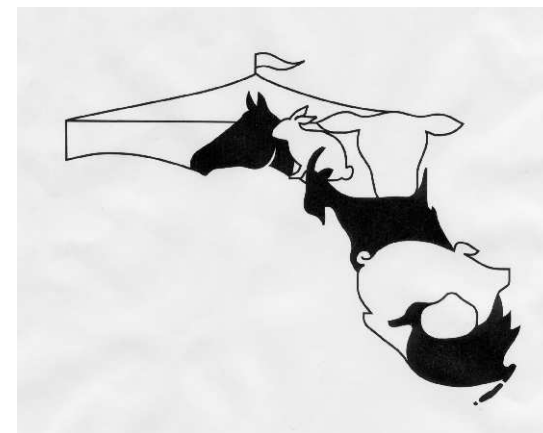
